We are Beatrix Potter Class

Beatrix Potter was born in 1866, in London, England. Although she lived in the busy city, she loved spending time in the countryside, where she could explore nature and observe animals. These peaceful visits inspired her stories and beautiful illustrations. Beatrix is best known for writing *The Tale of Peter Rabbit*, but she was also a talented artist. She used soft watercolours to paint her animal characters, giving them lifelike features and charming expressions.

Where is the Nursery entrance?



You will come in through the main entrance then go through the nursery gate.

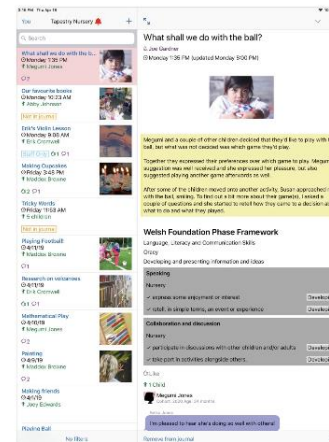

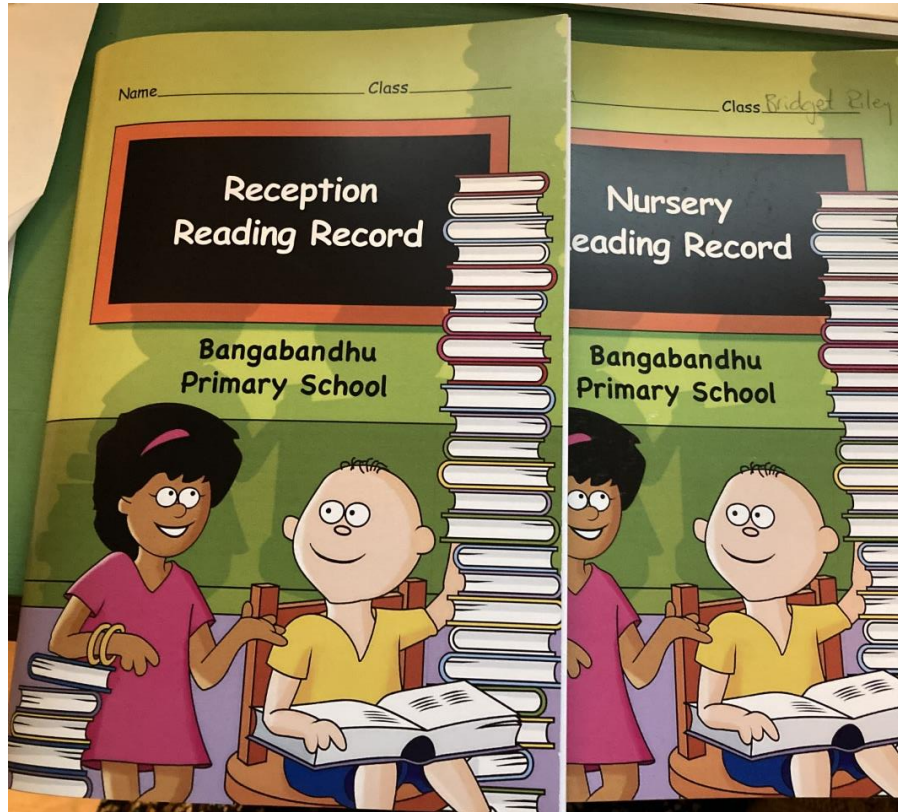

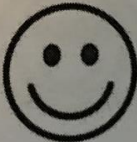
