Welcome to Robert Delaunay Class



Robert Delaunay (1885-1941) was a famous artist from France. He loved using bright colours, circles and shapes in his artwork.

Robert was born in 1885 and became famous for creating colourful paintings that looked full of **movement** and **energy**.

He enjoyed **experimenting** with different colours to see how they worked together. Many of his paintings are made up of colourful circles and patterns. This is similar to the way we explore colour, shape and pattern in Reception.

Online Learning Journals



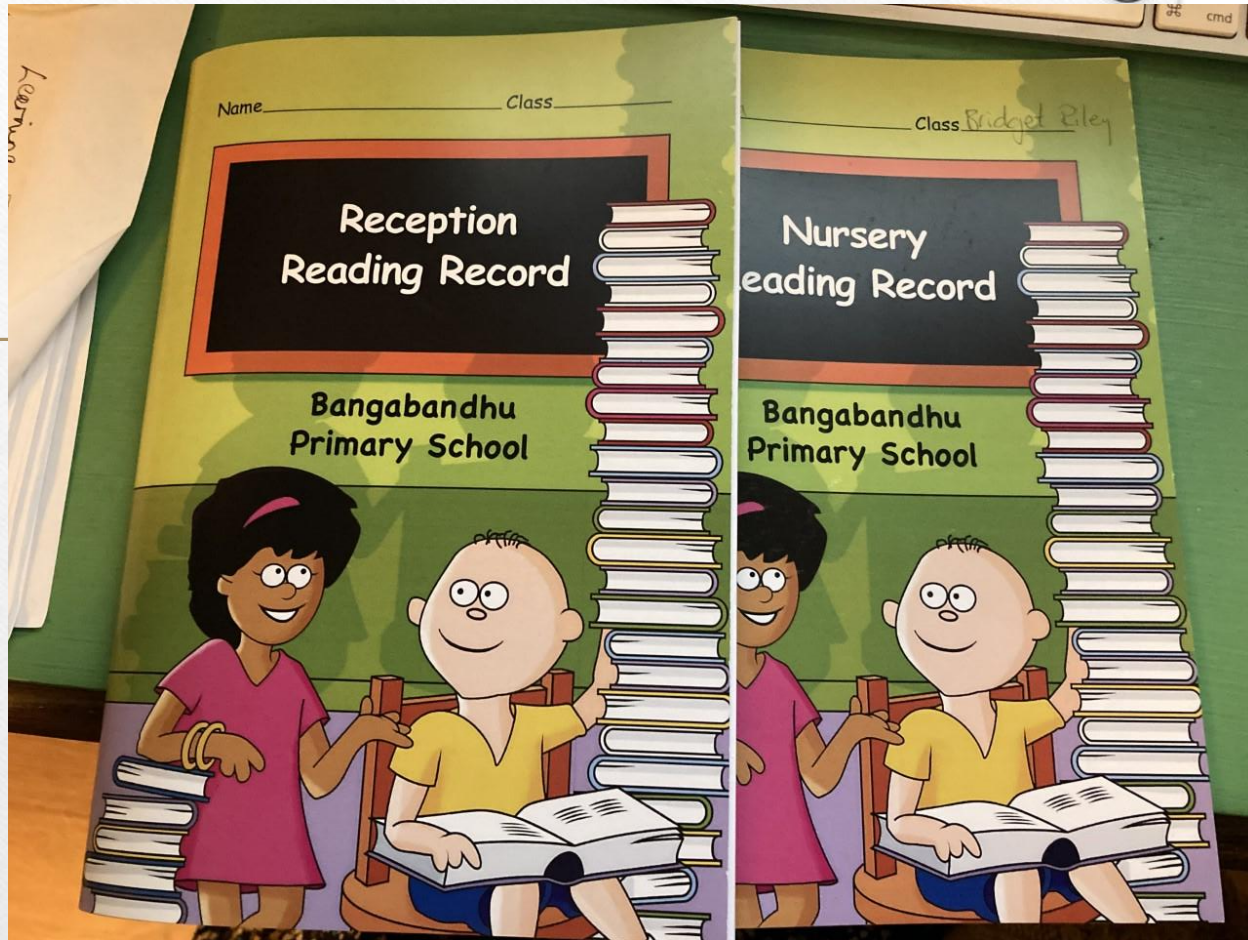
- Every child has an online learning journal.

A 'Must Read' book – to read with your child

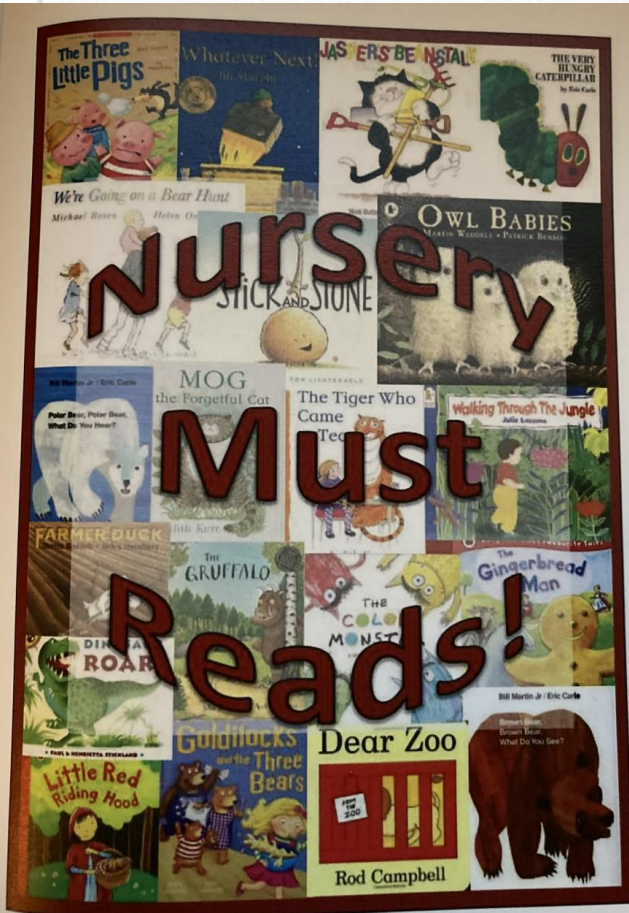
A book from the classroom or school library – to read with your child (Read, Write, Inc. Books – once the children are ready to start these, in Reception.)

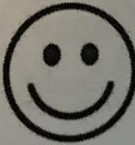
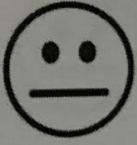


Must Reads
